A construction crane toppled over Wednesday near Pacific Coast Highway in Malibu, causing non-life-threatening injuries to the operator.

Fatal Crane Incident-Martinique, France



A new ship to shore crane collapsed at the port of Fort-de-France in Martinique last Thursday, September 18th, luckily no one was seriously injured. Two men were treated for minor injuries and a further 10 for shock. One man, in the cab or machinery room at the time was trapped on the 60 metre high crane for more than five hours.
